Fund Objective

The investment objective of the fund is to achieve long term growth through a blended investment strategy consisting of both growth and value stocks. All dividends are reinvested given their importance in driving long-term portfolio growth. The fund invests only in equities listed on the Stock Exchange of Mauritius.

Fund Manager Comments

The Fund was down 4.82% during the month while the SEMTRI had a negative performance of 2.76%. SEMTRI's performance was dragged by Financials (IBL Ltd -5.69%; SBMH -5.45%), Consumer Discretionary (Sun Resorts -12.28%) and Industrials (Rogers Ltd -12.99%).

Annual inflation stood at 11.9% YoY in September as compared to 11.5% YoY in August. PPI at 19.7% YoY in September as compared to 21.3% YoY in August.

Public debt rises 2.5% in Q3'22 compared to Q2'22 and stands at 85.2% of GDP.

Tourist arrivals at 638,332 from Jan-Sep 2022, representing 65.6% of 2019 levels during the same period.

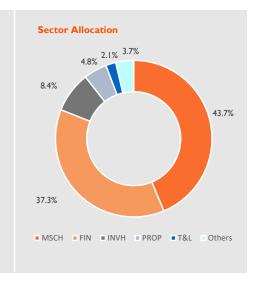
Bank of Mauritius intervened on the forex market, selling US\$40M to prevent a further slide of the Rupee.

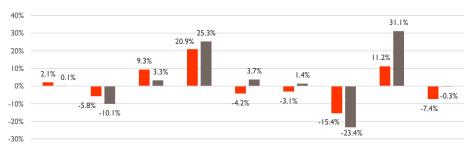
The Fund's investments have strong fundamentals with the actual portfolio expected to benefit strongly from an improvement in market conditions as business activities pick up.
